Not much is known about Bronze-Age beliefs but objects from the time suggest that the Bronze Age brought about big changes in religious practices. One of the greatest was that people stopped building large ritual monuments, such as stone circles. People also placed metal items, thought to be offerings to gods, in watery places, such as rivers, lakes, and bogs.
