"If I cannot inspire love, I will cause fear." For centuries, the story of Victor Frankenstein and the monster he created has held readers spellbound. On the surface, it is a novel of tense and steadily mounting dread. On a more profound level, it illuminates the

triumph and tragedy of the human condition in its portrayal of a scientist who oversteps the bounds of conscience, and of a creature tortured by the solitude of a world in which he does not belong. A novel of almost hallucinatory intensity, Mary Shelley's Frankenstein represents one of the most striking flowerings of the Romantic imagination.

Rock and Romanticism: Post-Punk, Goth, and Metal as Dark Romanticisms explores the relationships among the musical genres of post-punk, goth, and metal and American and European Romanticisms traditionally understood. It argues that these contemporary forms of music are not only influenced by but are an expression of Romanticism continuous with their eighteenth- and nineteenth-century influences. Rock and Romanticism: Blake, Wordsworth, and Rock from Dylan to U2 explores how rock and roll is a Romantic phenomenon that sheds light, retrospectively, on what literary Romanticism was at its different points of origin and on what it has become in the present.

Greenmantle is the second of John Buchan's novels to feature Richard Hannay, a Scottish intelligence officer in the British army, and as such is the sequel to *The Thirty-Nine Steps*. The book gives the account of Hannay and his associate's separate journeys through war-torn Europe to Constantinople to thwart an uprising that is poised to throw the Middle East, India, and North Africa into disarray, changing the course of the war. The book was popular when first published and although it has never been made into a film, the director Alfred Hitchcock was said to prefer *Greenmantle* to *The Thirty-Nine Steps*, and considered filming it on several occasions. This book is part of the Standard Ebooks project, which produces free public domain ebooks.

Though some critics have dismissed *The Excursion* as one of Wordsworth's weaker works, Wordsworth himself thought of it as one of his best. Like *Peter Bell*, *The Excursion* deals with a Wanderer who gathers stories throughout his travels.

Dubliners is a collection of picturesque short stories that paint a portrait of life in middle-class Dublin in the early 20th century. The collection had a rocky publication history, with the stories being initially rejected over eighteen times before being provisionally accepted by a

publisher then later rejected again, multiple times. It took Joyce nine years to finally see his stories in print, but not before seeing a printer burn all but one copy of the proofs. Today *Dubliners* survives as a rich example of not just literary excellence, but of what everyday life was like for average Dubliners in their day. William Sydney Porter (September 11, 1862 - June 5, 1910), known by his pen name O. Henry, was an American short story writer. O. Henry's short stories are known for their wit, wordplay, warm characterization, and surprise endings. *Cabbages and Kings* (1904) Main article: *Cabbages and Kings* (literature) A series of stories which explore aspects of life in a paralytically sleepy Central American town, each advancing some aspect of the larger plot and relating back one to another in a complex structure. The larger, overriding plot slowly explicates its own background, even as it creates a town which is one of the most detailed literary creations of the period. In this book, O. Henry coined the term "banana republic".

Some literary historians believe that *Dracula's Guest* is an excerpt excised from the original manuscript of Bram Stoker's masterpiece *Dracula* by an overzealous editor. This short novel recounts the travels of an unnamed Englishman who crosses paths with a foreboding wolf-like creature on his way to Count Dracula's castle.
